	<p>Ealing Fields High School Proposals for the former King Fahad Academy site on Little Ealing Lane</p>	<p>Proposals for the Ealing Fields High School permanent site at Little Ealing Lane were presented to neighbours and the local community at a public event on Wednesday 28 March. For those who were unable to attend, the information boards can be found at: http://ealingfields.org.uk/assets/files/Public-Consultation-Information-Boards.pdf</p> <p>The project team is now finalising the proposals for submission of the Planning application.</p> <p>Once submitted, Ealing’s Planning Department will conduct formal consultation before a decision on the application is made by the Planning Committee.</p> <p>It is then anticipated that work will commence in autumn 2018 and continue through to completion of the works in time for the school to open in the new premises in September 2020.</p> <p>Work has recently commenced to provide additional accommodation at the school’s temporary site at Wyke Gardens in Hanwell so that the school can remain there in the interim.</p>
