

'A' Level and University Results 2018

1. Graduates 2018

This year there were a total of nine students who graduated from University, eight with first degrees and one who graduated with a Post Graduate Course (nine graduated in 2017 and ten in 2016. One graduate result is yet to be confirmed. Another student is also due to graduate with a BSc Hons IT degree in January 2019 – this young person originally started his degree in Spring rather than in Autumn.

They graduated from the following courses:

As last year, the young people studied a wide variety of courses. Young people achieved excellent pass rates ranging from 1st Class to 2:1 and Pass degrees.

2. Courses and Institutions 2017/18

In the last academic year (2017/18) there were a total of 48 students studying at University level at 29 different institutions (compared to 45 in 16/17, 46 in 2015/16. A wide of courses were chosen, although Business, Criminology and Psychology are proving to be popular as are Universities in the London area (27/48 students studying at Universities in the London area). In 2017/18, 4/48 students were studying at Russell Group Universities (5/45 in 2016/17, 3/46 in 2015/16).

In the academic year 2017//2018 the Ealing Care Leavers were in the following University Years:

- Masters – 3 students (2 in 2016/17)
- Other Postgraduate 0 students (1 in 2016/17)
- Fourth Year – 1 student (0 in 2016/17)
- Third Year – 10 students (11 in 2016/17)

- Second Year – 16 students (14 in 2016/17)
- First Year – 18 (2 started mid-year) students (17 (2 started Feb 2017) in 2016/17)

During the Academic Year 2017/18, 2 students did not continue their degree courses, (5 in 2016/17). One student did not continue due health issues and is planning to complete his degree from September 2018 and another student has taken a break in his Masters and is currently working in the IT field.

At the start of 2017/18 we had 46 students at university. 44 of these young people were still studying at university in summer 2018 and four further students had commenced HE courses during the academic year bringing our end of summer total to 48 students at university.

We still also expect a total of 48 students to be studying at University during this academic year in 2018/19, which is 17% of the care leaver group (17%, 46 end of previous academic year). Our university percentage is consistent with the previous year even though our denominator of Care Leavers has increased. We still have a high number of young people studying at university as we did last year.

3. First Year University Student Trends

This September ten students will start University in their first year. Last year at this time in September we had sixteen students start University. 14 students qualified to start university in Sep 2018 and four of these students will commence HE Courses in Sep 2019

The table below shows the degrees that new 1st Year University students who are going to start in autumn 2018. It also shows the routes they took to achieve University entrance qualifications and the grades they achieved
