Neighbourhood Governance

## What are Ward Forums?

Led by its elected ward councillors, ward forums are public meetings where councillors and residents discuss local issues.

They were set up in 2008, and are supported by neighbourhood co-ordinators - council officers who follow up the business discussed at each meeting.

In Ealing, wards are arranged along the 23 council voting boundaries.



### North wards

Greenford Broadway, Greenford Green, North Greenford, Northolt Mandeville, Northolt West End and Perivale.

### South wards

Cleveland, Ealing Broadway, Elthorne, Hobbayne, Northfield and Walpole.

### East wards

Acton Central, Ealing Common, East Acton, Hanger Hill, South Acton and Southfield.

### West wards

Dormers Wells, Lady Margaret, Norwood Green, Southall Broadway and Southall Green.

## What we do

The main aim of ward forums is to engage and inform residents on council and non-council related matters that affect their area. This is achieved by:

- Acting as an **informal consultation forum** on council services and town centre/ neighbourhood developments including housing estates
- **Formally consulting** and providing comments on Controlled Parking Schemes, minor parking schemes and Controlled Drinking Zones
- Recommending an annual budget for spending on local improvements to benefit the ward
- Neighbourhood News newsletter

Outside the remit of ward forums:

- Discussions on planning applications
- Formal decisions on council spending



## What's been delivered



Since 2008, ward forums have delivered a range of improvement projects around the borough.

### Community support

(funding community activities, carnivals, festivals and events)

### Local environmental improvements

(tree planting, improvement to local monuments)

### Facilities for young people

(scout hut improvements, new equipment in play areas, funding activities and events)

### Traffic & highways schemes

(traffic-calming measures, yellow lines, footway paving, cycling schemes)

### Parks and open spaces improvements

(new play facilities, fencing, bins, signs, flowerbed planting)

### Community Safety schemes

(CCTV cameras, alley gating, additional lighting in streets and parks)
