1. Apologies for Absence

5. Minutes

Resolved:

That the minutes of the last meeting of the Boundaries Panel held on 9 February 2016 be agreed as a true and correct record subject to the following correction: Page 1, item 6 – replace 5 May 2015 with 5 May 2016.

6. Polling Place Changes – Local Government Elections and West Ealing Centre Neighbourhood Plan (WECNP) Business Referendum 3 May 2018

The Panel considered the proposals for alternative locations for polling places in polling districts DCA, HES, NGS, and UB.

The Panel noted the difficulties with the entrance and parking at HES and asked the Head of Elections to investigate whether there was an acceptable solution, however, the Panel agreed to the recommended change to polling place HES regardless of the outcome.

The Panel commented that the dynamics of NGS should be put forward in the Boundaries review for further consideration particularly in the context of the difficulties of finding an appropriate polling place within NGS. The Panel accepted the recommendation in the report.

Resolved:

That the Boundaries Panel:

- i) agrees to change the polling places for polling districts DCA, HES, NGS and UB, as set out in the attached appendix 1, for the purposes of the Local Government Elections 3 May 2018 and for any future elections and referenda :
- ii) notes that the changes to polling stations will be indicated on the relevant electors' poll cards.

- iv) requests that laminated signage be placed at previous polling stations directing electors to the new polling station locations.
- v) agrees to the use of one polling place, St Johns Primary School, Green Man Gardens, W13 0SE, the proposed polling place for UB, for the purposes of the West Ealing Centre Neighbourhood Plan (WECNP) Business Referendum 3 May 2018.
- vi) notes the overview of activity on the Local Government Boundaries Committee for England' review of Council size and boundaries as detailed in appendix 1B of the report.

Reason for Decision and Options Considered

The polling place changes for DCA, HES, NGS and UB are recommended as a matter of urgency in order to facilitate the forthcoming Local Government Elections to be held on 3 May 2018, for the reasons set out in Appendix 1.

The WECNP referendum area covers five polling districts (HFS, KA, UB, VA and VE), UB in its entirety and the other four in part, straddling four wards. A map showing the neighbourhood plan referendum area is attached at Appendix 2 of the report.

All five polling places for the above mentioned polling districts will be used for the WECNP Residential Referendum. Approval of the Boundaries Panel is sought to use only one central polling place for the WECNP Business Referendum, this to reduce costs and unnecessary administration. The polling place recommended is the proposed polling place for UB.

Business voter polling station turnout at the recent Central Ealing Neighbourhood Plan (CENP) Business Referendum equated to just two votes cast in person at each of the Business Polling Places. Over 90% of business registrants chose to vote by post.
