:All Commercial Waste Premises have been visited to establish their trade Waste Agreements, as there have been changes in ownership this will be continued to ensure that we have up to date information on files, We are now aware of the majority of the Commercial Waste Agreements for the Ward.

Hartington Road alleyway was cleaned by the Blitz crew earlier on this year,

The alleyway behind the shops in the Green has been cleared by May Gurney. Bags were investigated after this and trade waste issues were resolved

The week beginning March 1st sees British Waterways and Ealing working on the Canal Clean up, this will start at the Common and work its way up through Southall to Bankside on Saturday.

Southall Green PTD took place on January 19th, Commercial Premises were visited to check on their disposal, flytip removals and nuisance vehicles were addressed.

A major flytip on Commercial Land is in the process of being investigated and contact has been made with the Owners of this land with a view to removing all of the waste.

Several HMO's have been identified and passed to Regulatory Services for visits to be arranged.
