

## Update of Southall Green Activities Since November 2018 to Date

Number of Investigations into incidents of fly tipping = **3,977** (This figure indicates the number of searched fly tips completed, irrespective of whether evidence was found tip or not. It also includes Southall Broadway).

Number of warning letters issued to residents and business = **257**

Number of visits to businesses to ensure they're complying with their legal responsibilities (waste transfer notes) = **59**

Number of penalties issued to businesses for breaking the law (waste transfer notes) @ £300 each = **39**

Number of penalties issued to businesses for unlicensed street trading @ £150 each = 42 (this number includes Southall Broadway)

Number of litter & fly tipping penalties issued @ £150 each = **682** (the penalty increased to £150 on 1<sup>st</sup> April 2019. Prior to that it was £80.)

Number of fly tipping by businesses issued @ £400 each = **22**

Number of fly tipping by residents issued @ £400 each = **6**

Number of failures to comply with Section 47 - Failure of a commercial premise waste receptacle notice penalties @ £110 each = **3**

Number of community protection warnings (CPW) issued = **3**

Number of community protection notice (CPN) issued = **0**

Number of Abandoned Vehicles reported = **67**

### New Large Display 'A' Boards

In April 2019, Ealing Council extended the new concept of installing and additional 10x large display 'A' boards at strategically placed locations throughout the Southall Green Area. This was in addition to the 10x large display 'A' boards installed on The Broadway and South Road to raise awareness to residents and businesses that fly tipping, is not only serious, but also a crime. A neighbouring Authority has contacted this Council regarding this concept as they intend to emulate the same in their borough.

## **Update of Southall Green Activities Since November 2018 to Date**

### **Ealing's public spaces protected from illegal encampments**

In May 2019, the Council appeared before High Court and was granted a formal injunction that prohibits illegal encampments and depositing of waste on more than 300 sites across the borough.

### **Increase in 'On-Spot' Fines**

In April 2019, Ealing Council had adopted the Governments announcement that the maximum on-the-spot fine for litter, cigarette ends, dog fouling and fly posting has increased from £80 to £150.
