4.3)	Can demarcated parking bays be introduced in Coldershaw Road? This is due to poor vehicle parking, particularly of commercial vehicles.	Highways	Closed	Highways would normally only install demarcated parking bays if there was half carriageway/footway parking or a small car park to indicate parking spots. In this instance, there is not much benefit from installing demarcated parking bays along the entire stretch of the road as there are no restrictions on the road, therefore nothing to enforce in the way in which commercial vehicles park.
