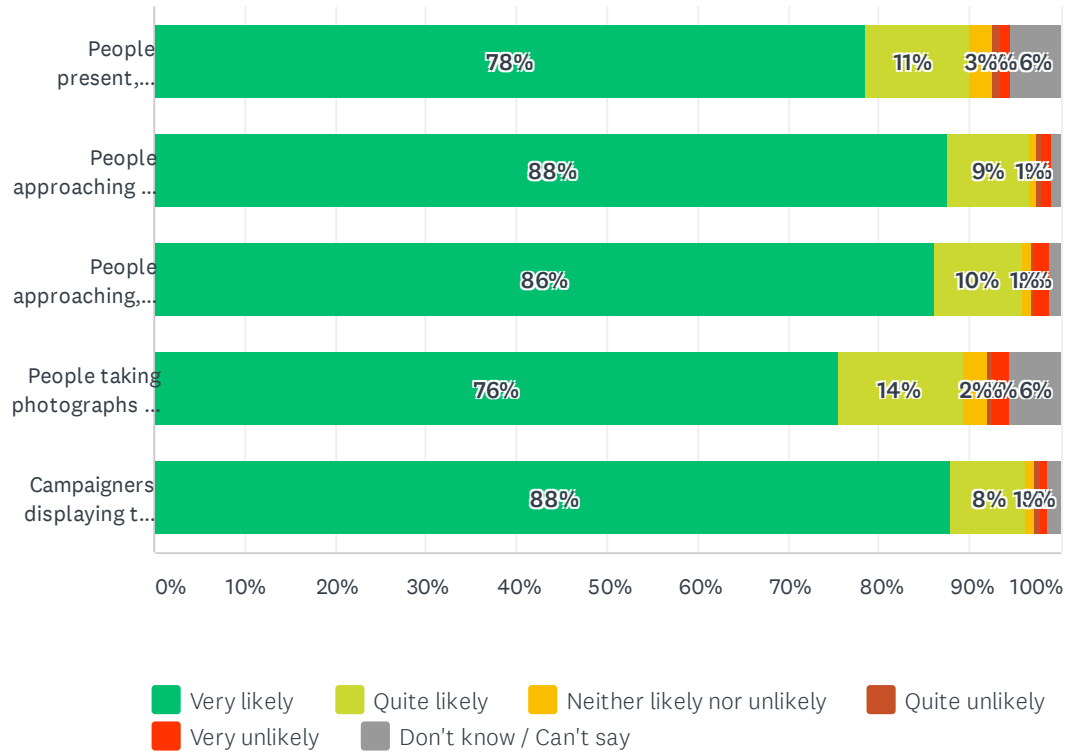

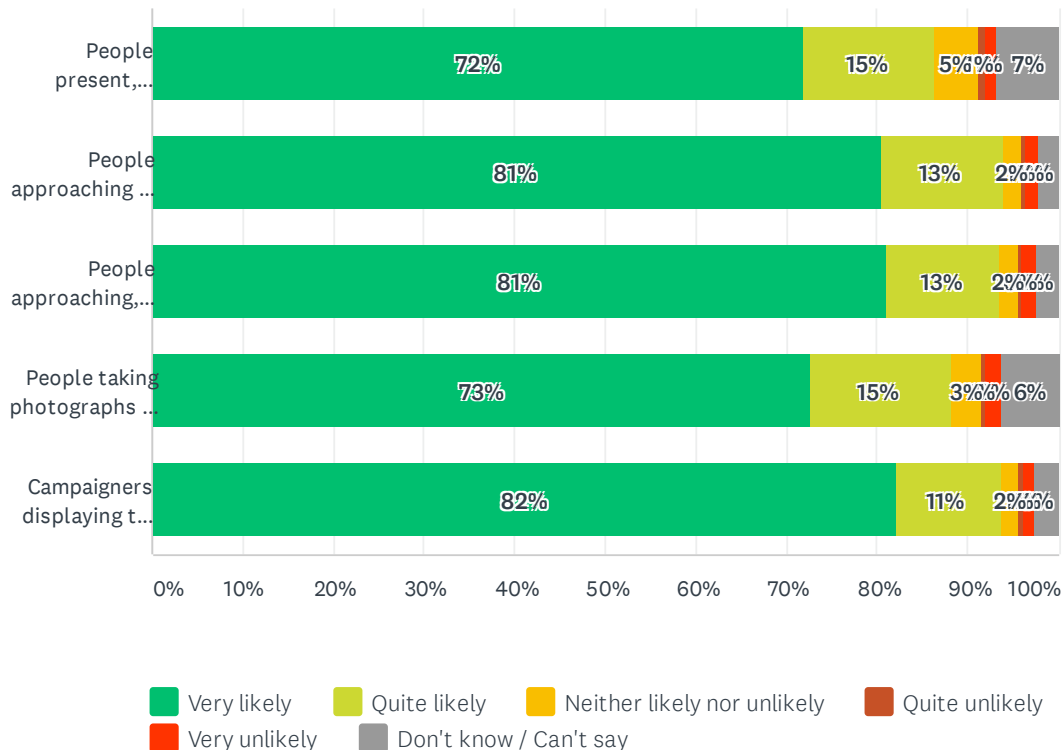

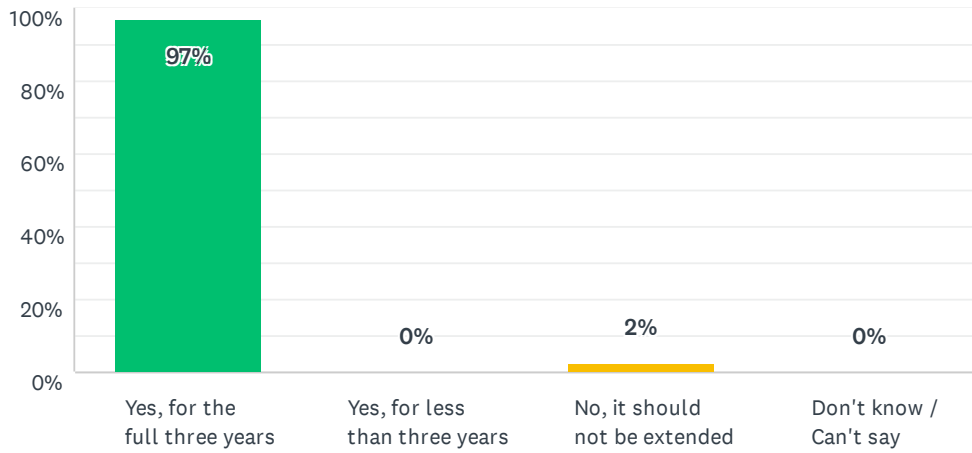

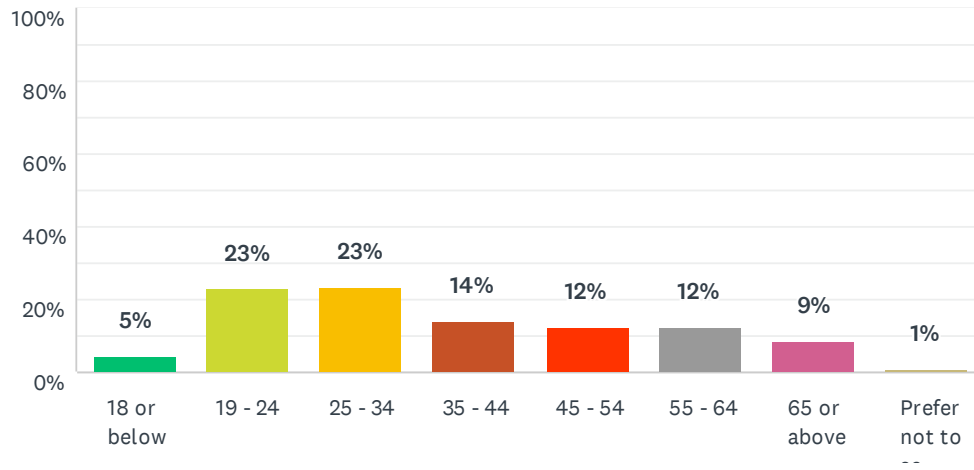

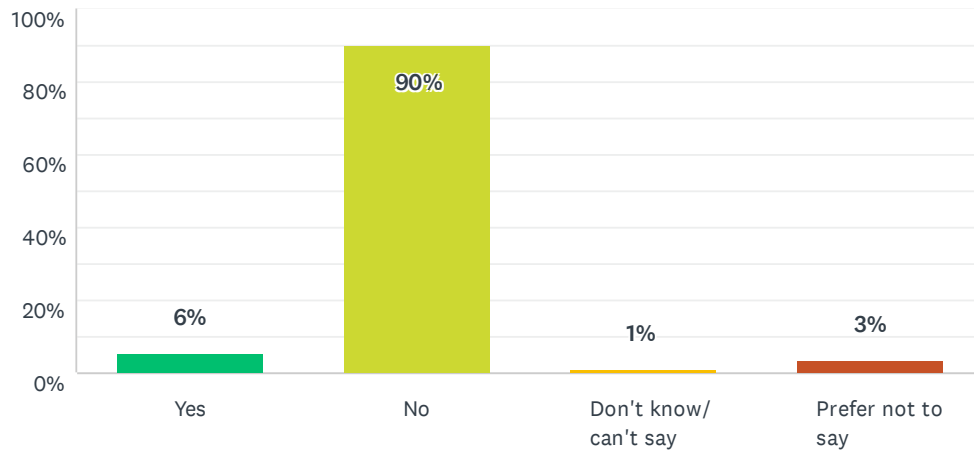

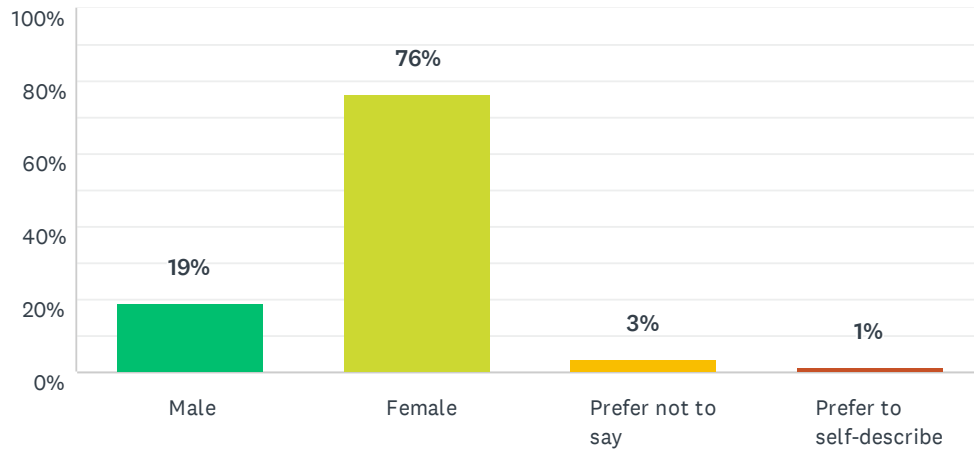

Q10 What is your gender?

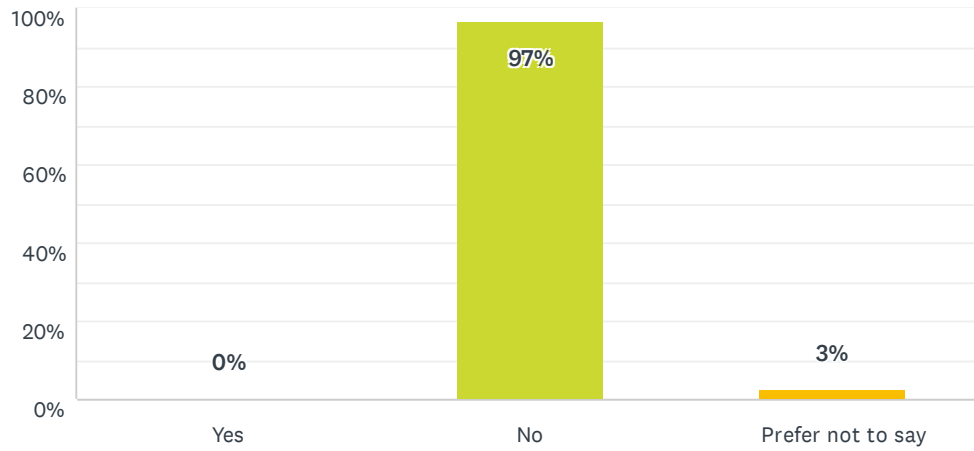

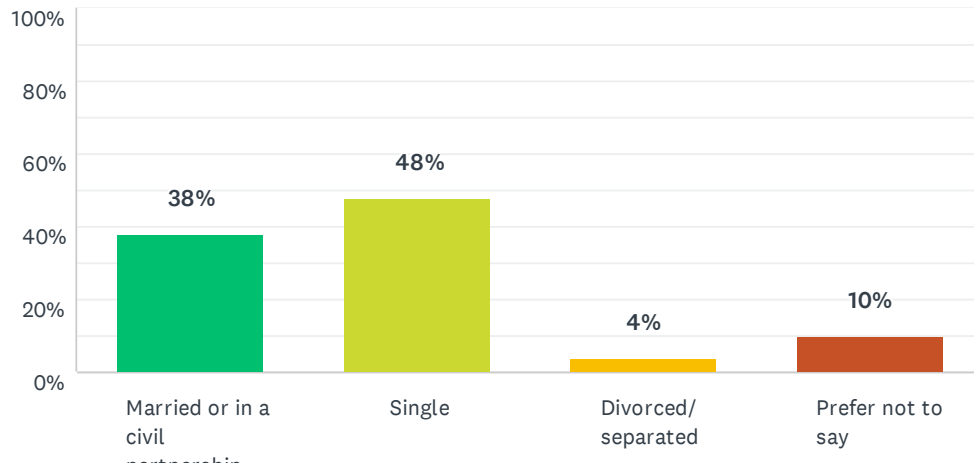

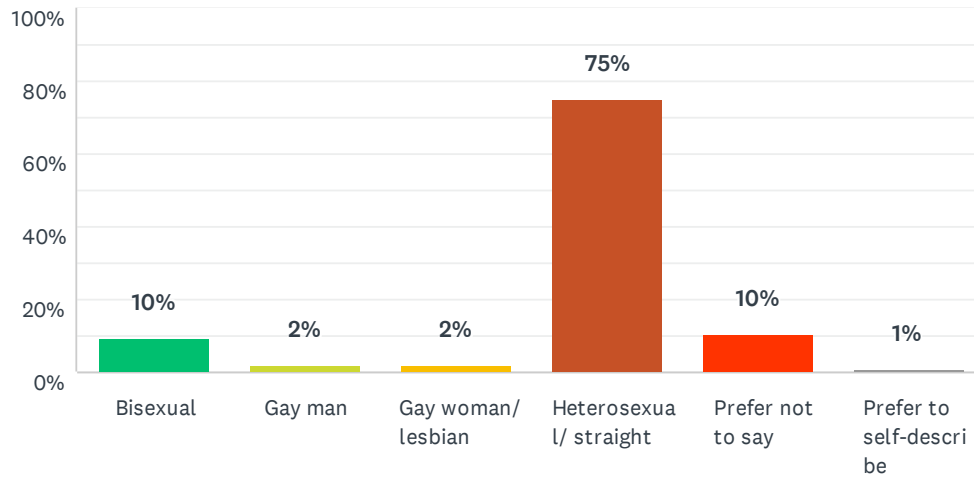

Q13 What is your sexual orientation?

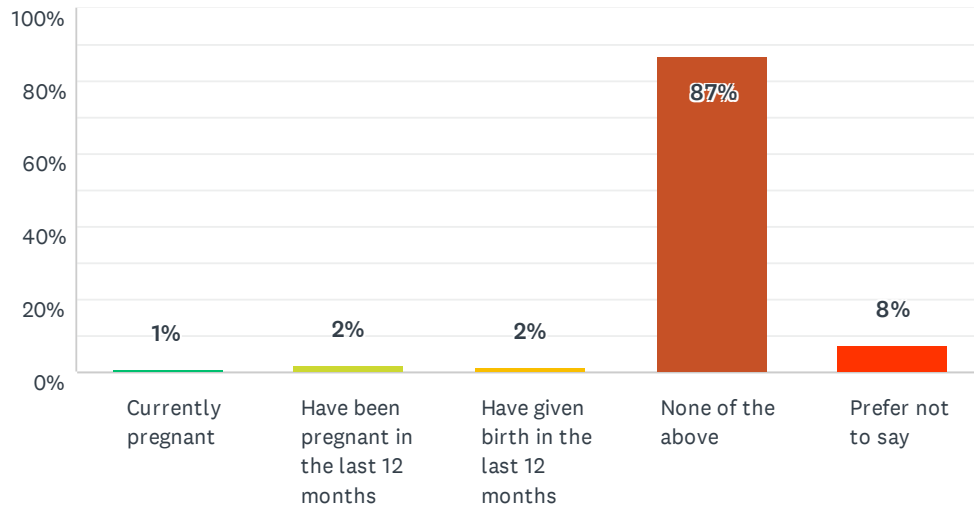

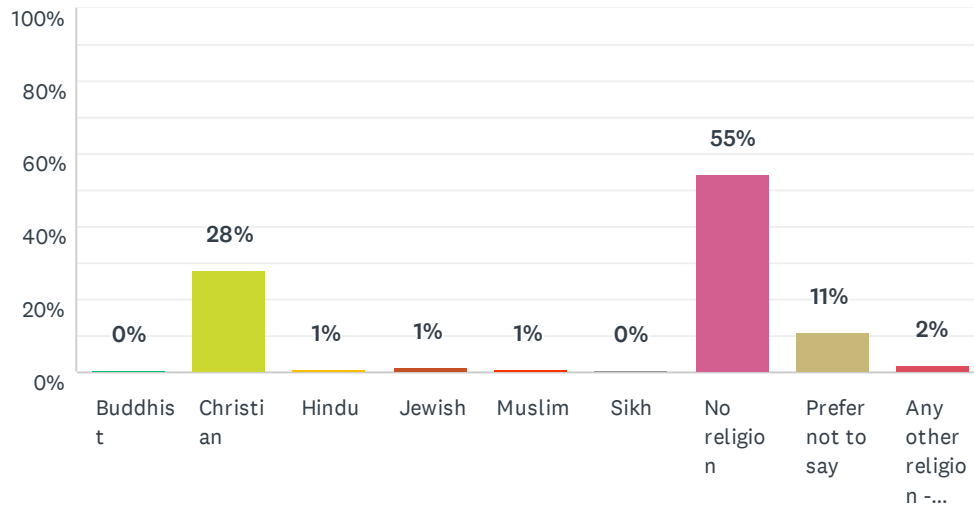

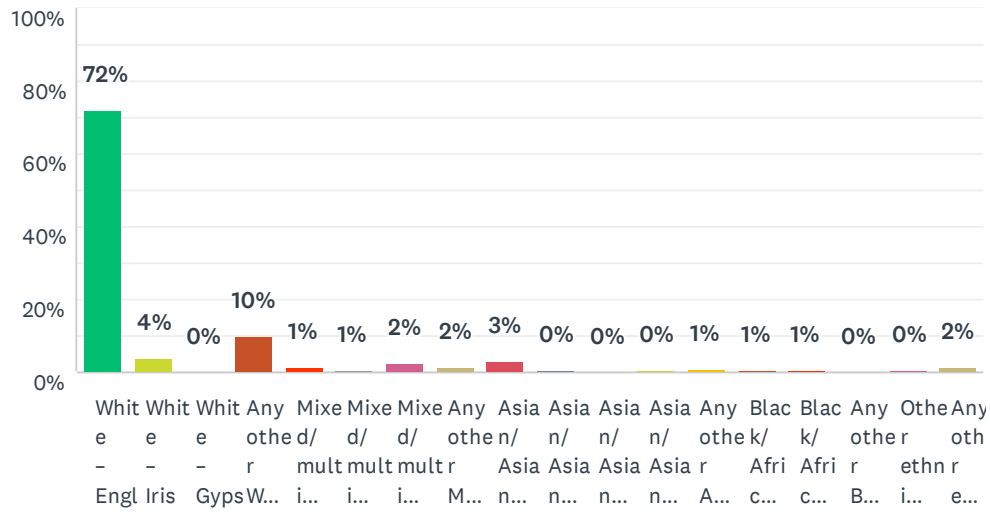
