Feedback from Site Visits

Ealing Street Pastors

- 1.2 The Panel had been invited to join the Ealing Street Pastors team on three of their **Ealing Broadway patrols** (Friday 25 October 2019, Friday 29 November 2019 and Friday 20 December 2019) which commence from the **Ealing Green Church, Ealing Green, Ealing, London, W5 5QT** at **10.30pm**. The patrols run in two sections with a break around 12.30am and end around 2.00-3.00am. Members could attend the first section until the break or carry on to the end.
- 1.3 Cllr Gary Malcolm joined the first patrol and had provided feedback at the last meeting. Cllr Karanvir Dhadwal (Chair), Cllr Seema Kumar (Vice Chair) and Cllr Praveen Anand attended the second patrol.
- 1.4 No Councillors joined the third patrol.

Northflix Cinema Club

- 1.5 On the afternoon (**13:30-15:30**) of **Saturday 8 February 2020**, the Panel is scheduled to attend a family screening of a Harry Potter film organised by the Northflix Cinema Club, a youth-led community film club, which is based at the **Northolt Library, Church Road, Northolt, UB5 5AS**.

Nishkam Sikh Welfare and Awareness Team – SWAT

- 1.6 Members had expressed an interest in attending the next **Nishkam SWAT outreach session** in **Strand/Charing Cross, London**.
- 1.7 Nishkam SWAT has yet to confirm the date.
